What is manual verification?

- All exam answer sheets are machine scored. Examinees who receive a failing score may request that their answer sheet be manually verified as well. A fee of \$75 is assessed by NCEES for each request.
- Requests must be made within 60 days of the release of exam results.

Why can't the afternoon portion of each Structural component be manually verified?

The afternoon portion of each Structural component is essay format and is scored and verified by at least two engineers from a committee of licensed structural engineers; a third engineer adjudicates any differences between the first two scores. Manual verification is available only for the morning portion of this exam.

What happens when my exam is manually verified?

- When NCEES receives your request and fee, the scoring department manually counts the correct responses on your answer sheet. The score is then recalculated and compared to the reported score to ensure there is no discrepancy.
- NCEES manually verifies the examinee's original answer sheets only. The discipline or depth module selected by the examinee during the registration process is the discipline or depth module that is verified.
- No specific examinee comments are addressed on manual verification requests.

What information will I get from a manual verification?

- If there is no change in your exam result, you will receive a letter from NCEES Exam Administration Services or your state board to inform you that there is no change.
- If your exam result changes from failing to passing, NCEES Exam Administration Services will notify you and your state board with the revised exam result.

How often has manual verification resulted in a change from a failing score to a passing score?

A manual verification has never resulted in a change from failing to passing.
