NCEES honors Texas professional engineer Govind Nadkarni for service

Govind Nadkarni, P.E., of Corpus Christi, Texas, has been awarded the NCEES Distinguished Service Award for his dedicated service to the engineering and surveying professions. Nadkarni received the honor at the organization's 91st annual meeting, held August 22–25, 2012, in St. Louis, Missouri.

Nadkarni has been a member of the Texas Board of Professional Engineers since 2000 and is a former board chair and vice chair. His contributions to NCEES include serving as its 2009–11 Southern Zone vice president and 2007–09 Southern Zone assistant vice president.

Nadkarni is an active member of several engineering societies, boards, and commissions in Texas and a mentor to young engineers. He was honored by the Texas Society of Professional Engineers as Young Engineer of the Year in 1984 and Engineer of the Year in 2004.
