## NCEES honors West Virginia professional engineer Lesley Rosier-Tabor for service

Lesley Rosier-Tabor, P.E., of Hurricane, West Virginia, has been awarded the NCEES Meritorious Service Award for her dedicated service to the engineering profession. Rosier-Tabor received the honor at the organization's 91st annual meeting, held August 22–25, 2012, in St. Louis, Missouri.

A licensed professional engineer since 1997, Rosier-Tabor has been the executive director of the West Virginia State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers for 10 years. She has served on many NCEES committees during this time, including the 2011–12 Committee on Examination Policy and Procedures.

For nearly 25 years, Rosier-Tabor has been an active member of the American Society of Civil Engineers at the national and state level. She is a past president of the organization's West Virginia section and has received several ASCE awards, including the 2010 West Virginia Civil Engineer of the Year.
