Huett honored for service to NCEES

William R. Huett of Montgomery, Alabama, has been awarded the NCEES Meritorious Service Award for his dedicated service to the engineering and surveying professions. NCEES recognized the 2011 award winners at its annual meeting, held August 24–27 in Providence, Rhode Island.

Huett has been a member of the staff of the Alabama State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors since 2002. He is currently assistant executive director and head of the investigative division for the board. Since joining the board staff, Huett has played a lead role in improving the board's enforcement efforts, dramatically reducing both the number of pending investigations and the time required to resolve investigations as well as developing a tracking system to better monitor the progress of investigations. Huett has contributed to the board's outreach efforts, giving presentations on enforcement, licensure law, and professional ethics to societies throughout Alabama. He also developed a mock licensure enforcement hearing for education purposes and has given presentations on licensure to engineering and surveying students in the state.

Huett's contributions to NCEES include serving on the Committee on Law Enforcement, including his two terms as chair, and developing law enforcement programs for NCEES annual meetings and NCEES Southern Zone meetings.
