## NCEES honors Oklahoma engineer Robert Zahl for service

Robert C. Zahl, P.E., AIA, of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, has been awarded the NCEES Distinguished Service Award for his dedicated service to the engineering and surveying professions. NCEES recognized the 2011 award winners at its annual meeting, held August 24–27 in Providence, Rhode Island.

Zahl has been a member of the Oklahoma State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors since 1999 and is a former board chair.

Zahl's contributions to NCEES include serving as a member of the Committee on Examinations for Professional Engineers and the Committee on Exam Policy and Procedure. He also served as the 2005–07 Southern Zone assistant vice president. He has also been active with exam development for NCEES, including serving on the FE exam development committee for 12 years.

Zahl is a past president of the American Council of Engineering Companies of Oklahoma, the Structural Engineering Council of Oklahoma, and the Oklahoma Council of Structural Engineering Associations.
