Mamola elected NCEES president-elect

Delegates elected Patty Mamola, P.E., NCEES president-elect at the organization's 91st annual meeting, held August 22–25 in St. Louis, Missouri. She will serve as president-elect for the 2012–13 term and as president the following year. She is the first woman to hold this position since the organization was founded in 1920.

A resident of Reno, Nevada, Mamola has been a member of the Nevada State Board of Engineers and Land Surveyors since 2006. She is a past board chair as well as a former NCEES Western Zone vice president.

Licensed as a professional engineer in Nevada since 1993, Mamola has focused her career on transportation, construction management, and analytical problem solving. She is one of the founding principals of the professional engineering firm Bowling Mamola Group.

Mamola is a graduate of South Dakota School of Mines and Technology, where she earned a bachelor's degree in civil engineering. She is an active member of the American Society of Civil Engineers, the American Council of Engineering Companies, and the American Public Works Association.
