2026 NCEES Annual Meeting—Summary for funded annual meeting delegates

Meeting dates and location	August 18–21, 2026 Westin Lake Las Vegas Resort and Spa 101 Montelago Blvd. Henderson, NV 89011
Meeting summary	<p>NCEES member boards meet as a group annually to conduct essential Council business. The purpose of the meeting is for delegates to vote on critical issues, including motions presented by NCEES committees and task forces, and the election of a new president-elect and treasurer. Attendees will also participate in professional forums and development workshops specific to their roles as engineers, surveyors, board administrators, and law enforcement staff.</p> <p>A draft meeting agenda follows this summary. A full schedule of events will be posted at ncees.org/annual_meeting when registration opens in May.</p>
Schedule and attendance requirements	<p>To qualify for funding, attendees must be present for all business sessions. The first business session begins at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, August 19. The business sessions conclude by 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 20. Funded first-time attendees must also attend the First-Time Attendee Breakfast on Wednesday morning.</p> <p>Plan to arrive on Monday, August 17. The business sessions are preceded by morning workshops and an afternoon plenary session on Tuesday, August 18. Professional forums and zone meetings are held on Wednesday. An optional Law Enforcement Workshop is offered on Friday, August 21. See below for more information about additional funding for those who choose to attend.</p>
Funding summary	<p>NCEES will provide the following funding, as applicable, for the member board administrator, qualified first-time attendees, and three eligible funded delegates from each board:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Complimentary annual meeting delegate registration▪ Lodging expenses for up to four nights (August 17–20)▪ Travel costs, per the Travel Policy (ncees.org/travel)▪ A travel stipend to cover incidental expenses accordingly<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ \$230 plus the approved mileage calculation for those approved to drive▪ \$575 for those who fly▪ Additional funding (hotel and stipend) for attending the Law Enforcement Workshop on Friday <p>The same funding is also provided to current committee chairs, zone officers, and past presidents of NCEES. Additional funding details follow this summary.</p>
Registration	<p>The cost of a delegate registration (\$450) will be waived for funded individuals. Meals include Tuesday’s welcome event; Wednesday’s breakfast and lunch; and Thursday’s breakfast, lunch, and dinner.</p>
Hotel room block rate	<p>NCEES will be direct-billed for the standard room rate (\$119/night for standard rooms, single or double occupancy), taxes, and mandatory fees for up to four nights (August 17–20). Taxes are currently 13.2 percent, and the mandatory resort fee is \$29 per night.</p> <p>NCEES will make the hotel reservations for all funded attendees based on information provided during registration.</p>
Travel	<p>Flying: In accordance with the Travel Policy, NCEES will be direct-billed for a funded traveler’s round-trip economy-class airfare when booked through Travel Incorporated. Delegates must follow instructions that will be provided in the meeting invitation.</p>

	<p>Driving: Travelers who drive to the meeting will be reimbursed for mileage up to 1,000 miles at the IRS-recommended rate. Delegates must provide the starting address during registration. The calculated amount will be added to the travel stipend check.</p> <p>Parking: Self-parking is included in the resort fee.</p>
Travel stipend	<p>No expense reports are necessary to receive the travel stipend. The check will be made payable to the individual (unless specified during registration) and will be received at the meeting. This is intended to cover expenses such as home airport parking, ground transportation, baggage fees, dinner on Wednesday night, breakfast on Friday morning, and incidental hotel charges, such as tips. The stipend includes an additional allowance for off-property ground transportation (e.g., Uber or Lyft).</p> <p>A list of suggested ground transportation options will be available online at ncees.org/annual_meeting when registration opens.</p>
Law Enforcement Workshop (optional)	<p>Participation in the Law Enforcement Workshop: Investigation 101 on Friday is an optional benefit for annual meeting attendees. The workshop includes breakfast and lunch on Friday.</p> <p>NCEES will fund a fifth night at the hotel (August 21) for those who stay and attend the entire program. Participants will also receive an additional stipend of \$50 to cover additional incidental expenses, such as dinner on Friday night.</p>
