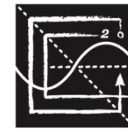


**MINUTES OF THE 2026 CENTRAL/NORTHEAST ZONE JOINT

Call to order

Vice President Etoniru called the Northeast Zone meeting to order at 3:20 p.m.

Approval of 2025 Northeast Zone annual meeting minutes

Sallye Perrin, P.E. (MD-PE) made a motion, which was seconded by James Purcell, P.E. (NJ) to approve the 2025 Northeast Zone annual meeting minutes. The meeting minutes were approved unanimously.

Committee reports

Nominating Committee

James Purcell, P.E. (NJ), acting chair of the Nominating Committee in the absence of Nominating Committee Chair Barry Lucas, P.E. (DC), acknowledged the members of the Nominating Committee: Barry Lucas, P.E. (DC); Jane Hardy (CT); Windsor Tracy, P.L.S. (PA); and Jennifer Wootten (DE-PE). He then opened the floor for the zone secretary nominations. Thomas (TJ) Frazier, P.L.S. (MD-PS) nominated Jeanne Nebre, P.S. (MD-PS) for zone secretary. The motion was seconded by Robert Kudlawiec, P.E. (PA) and Sallye Perrin, P.E. (MD-PE). Having no other nominations, Purcell moved that Nebre be elected zone secretary by acclamation. The motion passed unanimously.
