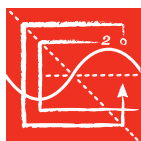


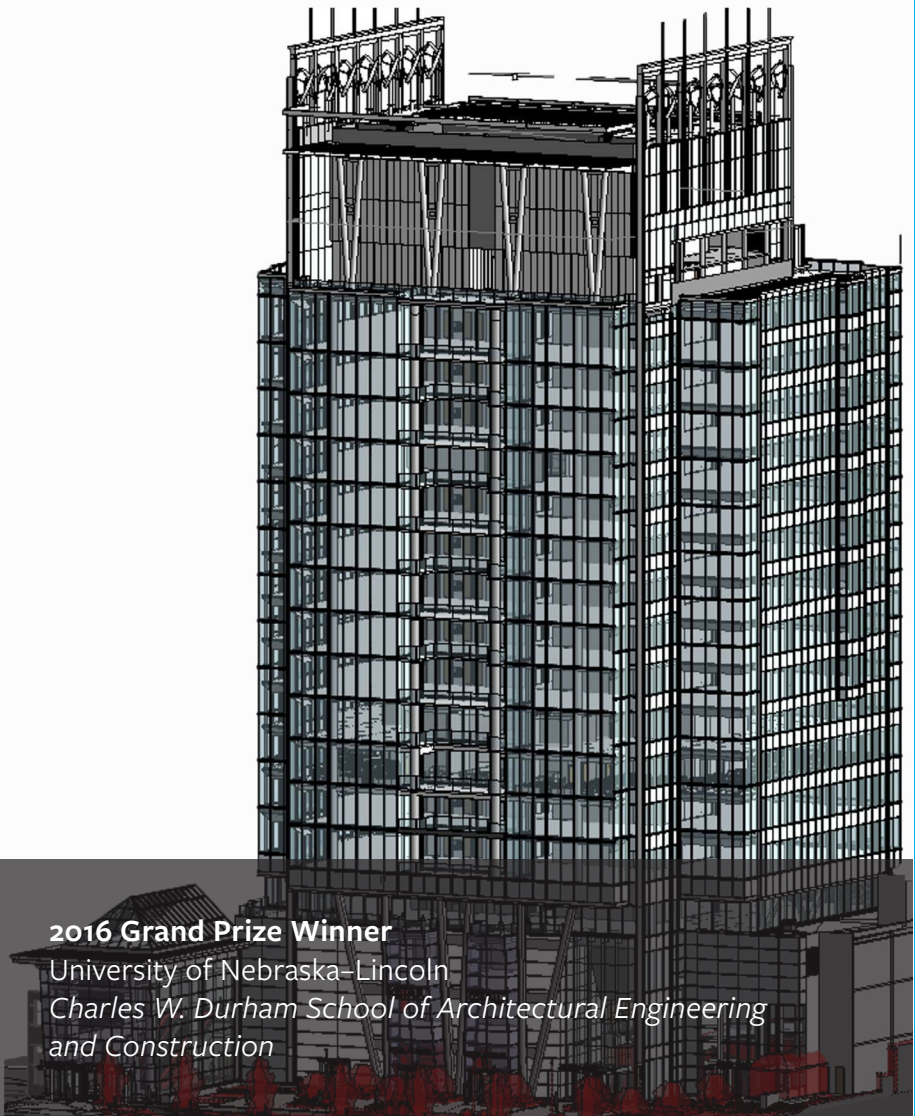

Entry Requirements

Each submission must include a completed entry form, an abstract, a project description, and a display board. These files must be submitted electronically at ncees.org/award.

Evaluation Criteria

- Successful collaboration of faculty, students, and licensed professional engineers
- Protection of health, safety, and/or welfare of the public
- Multidiscipline and/or allied profession participation
- Knowledge or skills gained
- Effectiveness of display board, abstract, and project description



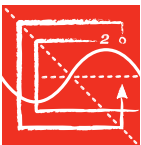
